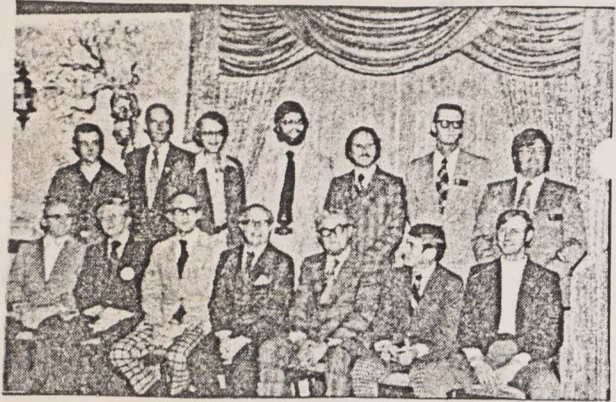

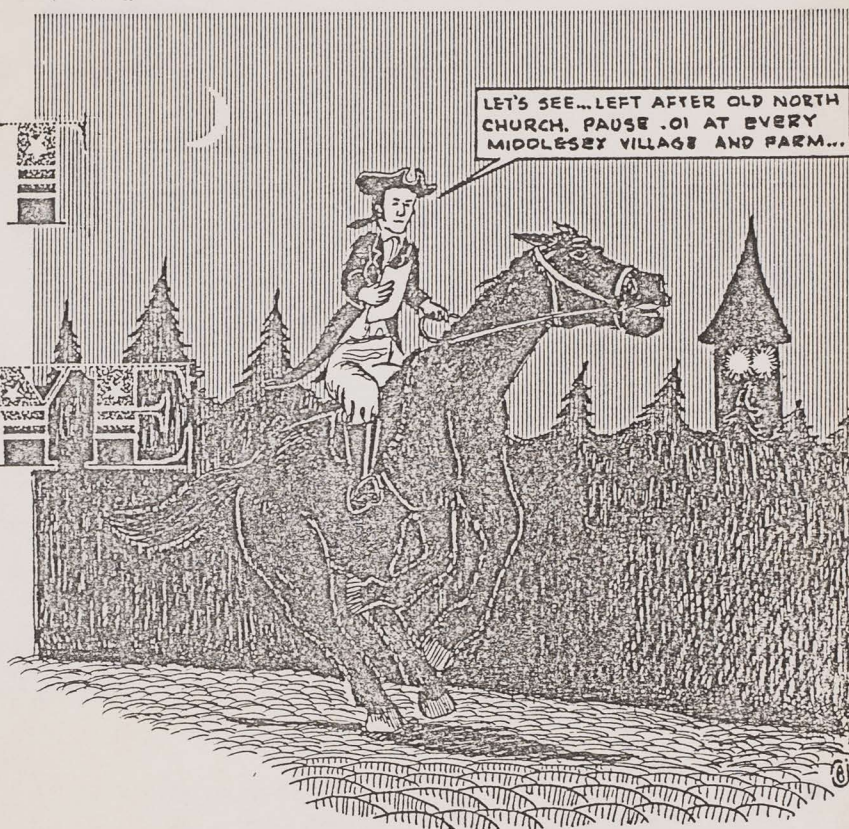

General Instructions will be handed out at the February VMSC meeting, or mailed upon request.

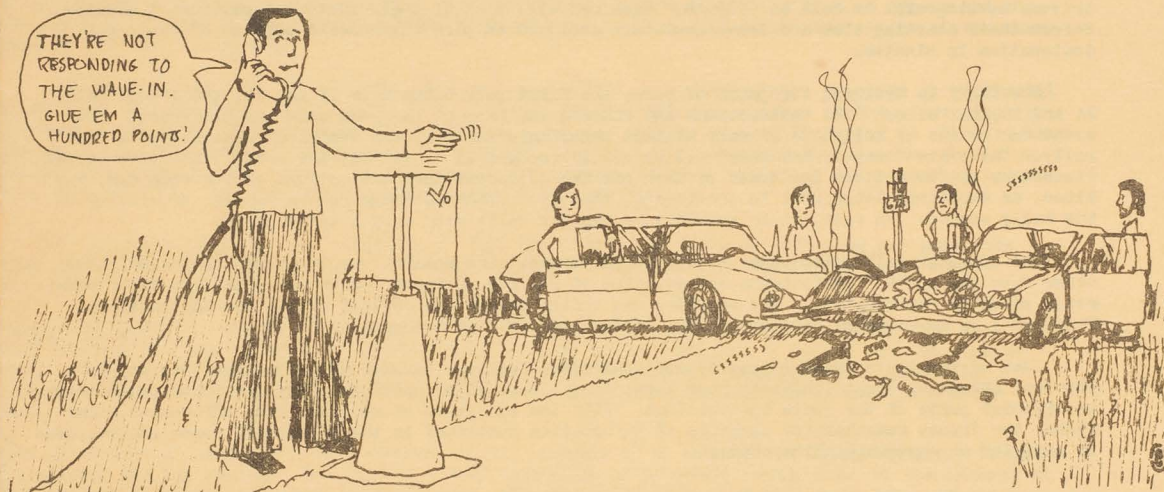
