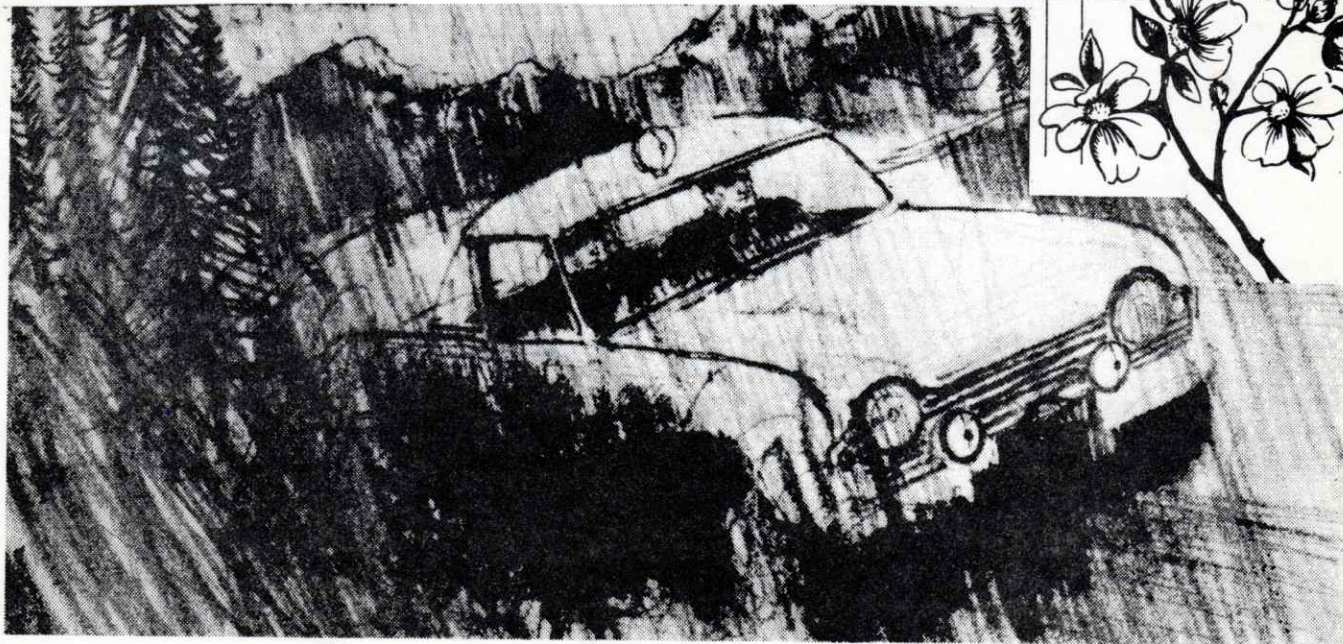
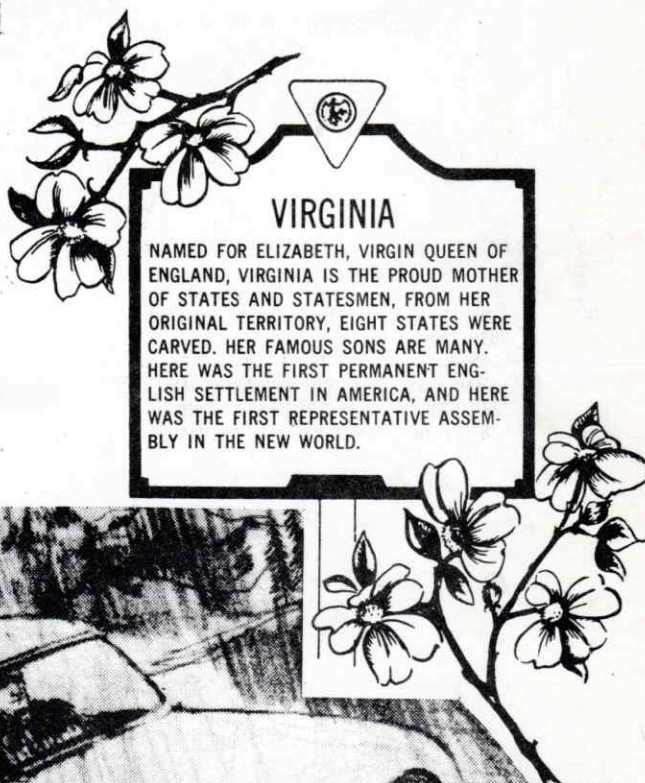

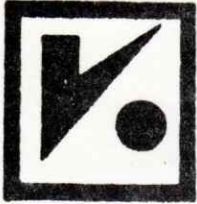

We have a new board member, he's not as cute as Judy Baylor, but Porter Seay will fill the vacancy.

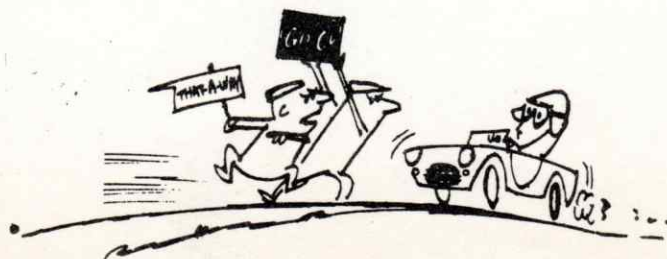

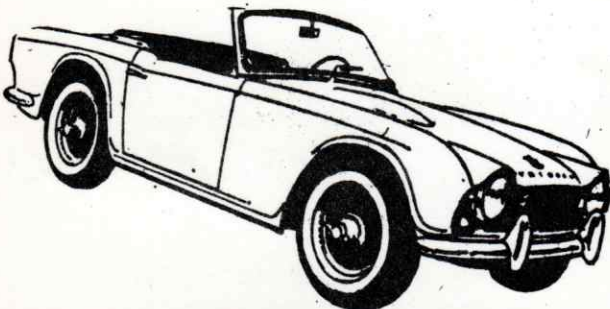
