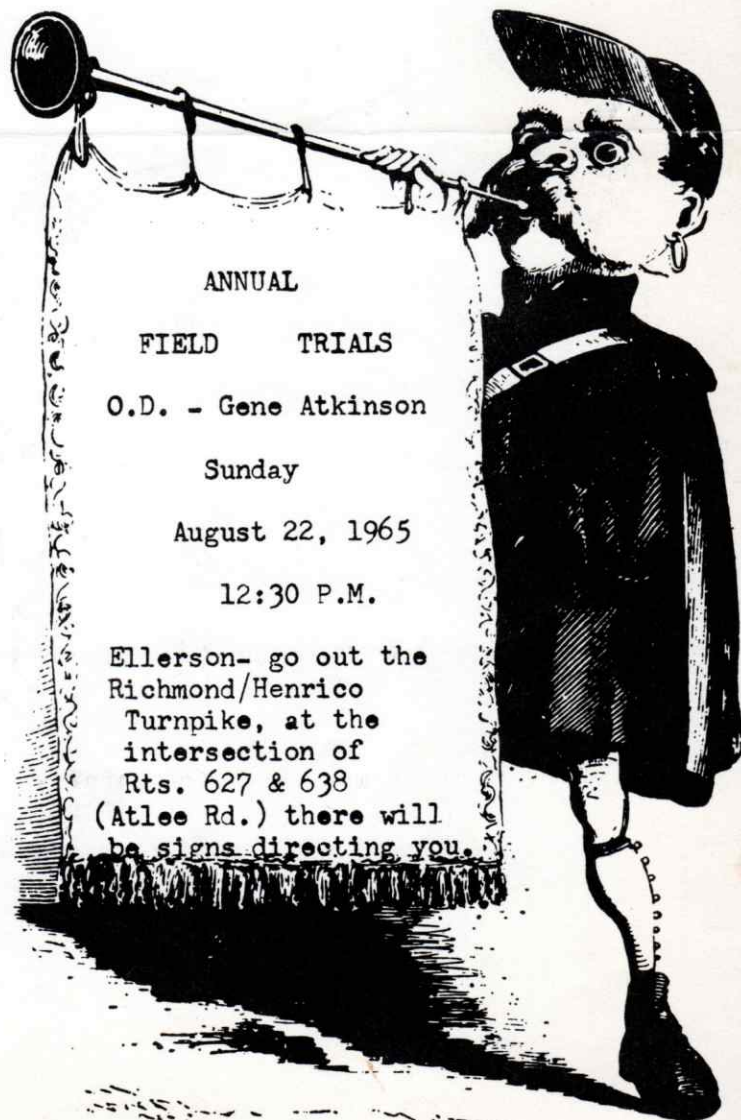

As I said before it was a very well planned rally, and there was a very good turnout. Keep up the good work Charlie.

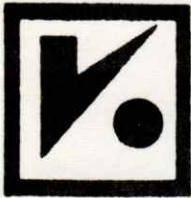
